The Crossing is an intensive outreach case management service for young people aged 16-25 years experiencing homelessness or who are at risk of homelessness.

The young people we work with face complex challenges such as family conflict and breakdown, domestic violence, legal issues, mental illness, alcohol and other drug, disability and financial crisis. This often results in unstable accommodation, disengagement with education, work and their community.

Through our services, we deliver a combination of practical support and guidance to help young people turn their lives around and reach their goals.

Who we support

The Crossing work alongside young people who are homeless or at risk of homelessness and/or experiencing difficulty accessing services due to high and or complex needs.

How we support you

- Intensive, long term case management that is tailored to each young person's needs
- Outreach model working with young people in the community
- Advocacy, advice & information
- Practical assistance & referrals to access services including accommodation, educations & employment, health & mental health, disability, drug and alcohol, & income support
- Personal & living skills development
- Informal counselling
- Empowerment to work towards achieving goals and improving quality of life.
- Promotion of harm minimisation
